

A three day science awareness camp on "Popularisation of Science for School Students and Society" was held in our college from 25th to 27th September, 2019. Sixteen schools (Thirteen Bengali medium, two Hindi medium and one English medium) in the periphery of our college are selected to participate in the camp (names of schools are listed below). In mathematics, computational methods using modern technology helped them to pursue career in future. In geography, we intend to show some instruments that are used in surveying purpose.

In brief, through this Science awareness camp we tried to develop their efficiency using the way of observation, experimental demonstration, analytical approach and hand-on experiments.

The poet's favorite season was the monsoon. It was during this monsoon that he departed, leaving the entire nation bereft and desolate.

In Tagore's poetry, the theme of death appears in various forms. Throughout his life, he faced death repeatedly. His mother passed away at a young age, followed by the death of his beloved sister-in-law, Kadambari Devi, before he reached middle age. At 41, he lost his wife, and he also outlived his two daughters, a son, and a grandson. Thus, he expressed death in many ways through his poetry. We observe Rabindranath's Death Anniversary to deeply reflect upon his life and work. On this occasion, we remember his life and his creations repeatedly.
