



Modalities for UG Intermediate Semesters (II & IV) Examinations 2021

The University authority after careful consideration of all relevant Orders/Notifications received from the competent authorities has prepared the modalities of conducting the UG intermediate Semester (Sem-II & IV) Examinations 2021. The following Guideline is being sent to the affiliated colleges for strict compliance of the same.

- i. Assessment of examinees shall be based on internal evaluation and previous semester.
- ii. Grading of the examinees will be composite of 50% marks on the basis of the pattern of internal evaluation adopted by the universities and the remaining 50% marks will be awarded on the basis of performance in previous semester only (if available).

Explanation: Grading of Examinees of regular and backlog candidates of Semester-II and Semester-IV will be done by combining 50% weightage from Internal Assessment / Evaluation and 50% weightage from the Average of the Percentage Marks obtained by the candidate in Semester I and III respectively.

- iii. In the situations where previous semester marks are not available, 100% evaluation will be done on the basis of internal assessment/evaluation.
- iv. Internal Assessment/evaluation of AECC-2 will be fixed at 10 marks. In this course no marks be allotted for attendance like SEC.
- v. In case of NA candidates, actual performance of the immediate previous semester will be taken into account to calculate 50% weightage.
- vi. Only enrolled students will be considered as examinees and only their results will be processed for publication. Admit cards will also be issued for these examinees, however, with revised instructions.
- vii. Provision of Review and Scrutiny will not be considered for these examinees (Semester II, Semester IV, 2021).
- viii. If any candidate wishes to improve the grades, he/she may appear in special examinations for such subject during next semester within prescribed chance(s) and if situation permits.
- ix. Candidates are directed to fill in their respective examination form(s) after checking and fulfilling their own eligibility criteria to appear at the semester examination concerned. Mere filling in the examination form does not confirm the chance to appear at the respective Semester, if the candidate fails to comply/satisfy his/her eligibility criteria as prescribed in the existing UG Examination Regulation. The University will not be liable to such cases.

The above mentioned modalities are applicable for the aforesaid semesters (II & IV) Examinations 2021 only.
