NOTIFICATION

It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that a meager number of students filled in the examinations forms relating to Sem-VI Exam-2021 without following—

1. Existing Regulation relating to UG Examinations under CBCS,
2. Guidelines to the UG Examinees of Terminal Semester Examination-2021 dated : 26.07.2021

Hence, those candidates are not eligible to appear in the Semester-VI Examinations-2021. In consequence, there is no question of generating Admit Cards for the said candidates. However, payment made for filling up their forms be refunded to the colleges.

For further information, relevant part of the UG Regulation and Guidelines are mentioned below:

- i. *A candidate (Regular/Back) shall have to complete Sem-I, Sem-II, Sem-III, Sem-IV, Sem-V & Sem-VI Honours/General Examinations within seven (7) consecutive years including his/her original year of enrolment in Sem-I Examination subject to the condition that not more than three (3) consecutive chances shall be allowed in each Semester. [U.Reg.(CBCS) 5]*
- ii. Candidates are directed to fill in their respective examination form(s) after checking and fulfilling their own eligibility criteria to appear in that semester/part of examination. Mere fill in of examination form does not confirm the chance to appear at the respective Semester/Part of examination if the candidate fails to comply/satisfy his/her eligibility criteria as prescribed in the existing UG Examination Regulation. The University will not be liable to such cases. [Modalities issued by the Controller of Examinations, BU]
